SIXTY-FIFTH INDIANA REGIMENT

1 of 2

"The Sixty-Fifth Regiment was organized under the call of July, 1862, at Princeton, and was mustered in at Evansville, (with the exception of Company "K,") on the 18th and 20th of August, 1862, with JOHN W. FOSTER as Colonel. The nine companies were at once moved to Henderson, Kentucky, where it went into camp to protect the place from guerrillas. On the 27th of August; the regiment embarked on transports, and went up Green river to Ashbysburg, landing at 9 o'clock in the night. Marching all night, it attacked Adam Johnson's rebel regiment the next morning, and after a severe skirmish, and some loss to the enemy, the regiment took possession of the town of Madisonville. Company "K" was mustered in on the 10th of September, and joined the regiment in the field. After the engagement at Madisonville, the companies were distributed in different counties in that portion of Kentucky west of the Nashville railroad, and there remained on duty until the 18th of August, 1863, when they all reported at Glasgow. Here the regiment joined Col. Graham's brigade of cavalry, the regiment having been mounted in April, 1863, by order of Gen. Burnside. The companies, while on the local duty above mentioned, engaged the enemy as follows: Company "D" in a skirmish near Vanderburg, on the 12th of September, 1862, losing one killed and six wounded, and on the 13th it had another skirmish, in which three were wounded. Company "E" had a skirmish at Dixon, on the 29th of July, 1863, losing one man wounded.

The regiment was moved to the field in East Tennessee, arriving at Knoxville on the 1st of September, the brigade to which it was attached being the first Union troops to arrive at that point. During this march Col. Foster assumed the command of the brigade. Several companies of the regiment were sent out on a raiding expedition, returning to Knoxville after an absence of two days. On the 5th of September the regiment marched up the valley, and taking possession of a captured train of cars, moved up the valley one hundred and ten miles above Knoxville, capturing on the way another train and two locomotives, besides other property. Returning from this expedition on the night of the 6th, it moved the next day with its

brigade up the same valley, and on the 20th engaged the enemy near Zollicoffer. On the 22d a severe fight was had with the enemy at Blountsville, in which the regiment lost fifteen in killed and wounded. The Sixty-Fifth was engaged in another fight at Rheatown, on the 11th of October, in which Company "A" had one man wounded. On the 14th of October the regiment fought the enemy at Blountsville without loss, and on the 15th at Bristol, losing one man captured.

On the 17th of November the regiment moved with the division across to Tazewell, and on the 1st of December it had a severe fight at Walker's Ford, Tennessee, assisted by the Fifth Indiana Cavalry, in which both regiments fought all day against great odds, the Sixty-Fifth losing two killed, eight wounded and two missing. Company "K" at this time was at Mulberry Gap, numbering forty-five men, from whence it expelled a whole rebel regiment by a night attack. After Longstreet's retreat the regiment and all the cavalry had a battle with Longstreet's infantry at Bean Station, on the 14th of December, in which the regiment lost two killed, ten wounded and five missing. On the following day it fought at Powder Spring Gap, losing ten wounded and four missing, and on the same day again engaged the enemy at Skaggs' Mills, losing one killed and two captured. On the 17th of January, 1864, the regiment had a fight at Danridge in which one man was mortally wounded.

On the 21st of April, 1864, the regiment was dismounted and assigned to the Second Brigade, Third Division, Twenty-Third Army Corps, and on the 30th of April it joined Sherman's army, then about moving on its Atlanta campaign. It was in the battle of Resacca on the 14th of May, and in all the skirmishes and battles of this campaign, up to the capture of Atlanta, sustaining a loss of eleven killed, twenty-three wounded and five prisoners; total, thirty-nine. The regiment participated in the march in pursuit of Hood into Alabama and Tennessee, engaging the enemy at Columbia, Tennessee, and at Franklin on the 30th of November, '64. In the battle of Nashville, on the 15th and 16th of December, it bore a conspicuous part. After this it moved to the Tennessee river in pursuit of Hood's retreating army.

In January, 1865, the regiment was transferred to Alexandria, Virginia, and from thence sailed to the vicinity of Fort Fisher, near Wilmington, North Carolina, and after landing bore the brunt of the attack on Fort Anderson, on the 18th of February, 1865, and did the skirmishing for the troops at Town Creek on the 20th. The regiment was not afterwards engaged, but moved to Greensboro, with the Twenty-Third Corps, after the surrender of Johnson's army, where on the 22d of June, '65 it was mustered out of service, and proceeded to Indiana, and was finally discharged at Indianapolis, soon afterwards.

The regiment, during its term of service, has lost as follows: Killed, twenty-six; wounded, eighty-six; captured, sixty-one; total, one hundred and seventy-three."
